Cookie Policy

When you use our website to view information we make available, a small number of cookies may be used by us and/or by third parties to allow the website to function, to collect useful information about visitors and to help to make your user experience better.

What are cookies?

A cookie is a small file of letters and numbers that is downloaded on to your device, your computer, smartphone, or tablet, when you visit a website. Cookies are used to help a website remember information about your visit, which can make it easier when you visit the site again and make the site more useful to you. Cookies can do many things like remembering your preferences, recording what you have put in your shopping basket, and counting the number of people looking at a website.

What cookies are used on the Welshpool & District u3a website?

The Welshpool & District u3a website (www.welshpool.u3asite.uk) may set cookies on your device. The cookies we use are strictly necessary for the website to function. We do not use cookies that store any personal or identifying information.

We do not use Google YouTube cookies.

We do not place any advertising or targeting cookies.

Do I have to allow the cookies that are used on the Welshpool & District u3a website?

In short, no, you do not have to allow cookies. Cookies can be disabled in your browser settings and each browser works slightly differently. You can decide to only allow cookies from websites you trust, or to block all cookies. If you decide to disable cookies for this site, then this will lead to some reduced site functionality.
